Canvas

- * Canvas Explore with your student!
- * Grade in Canvas is NOT the actual grade (use systems.mckeelschools.com)
- * Modules, Modules!! I organize EVERYTHING in Canvas through Modules. Once Modules has been selected students will select the current unit and everything will be there.
- * All modules will stay unlocked throughout the year so that students can continuously review and prepare for FSA/EOC and their cumulative final exam

What is a "Flipped Classroom"?

- * A "flipped classroom" is a classroom where what used to be class work (the "lecture") is done at home via teacher-created videos and what used to be homework (practice problems) is now done in class.
- * This allows students to get individual time in class to work with their teacher on key learning activities.
- * Traditional Classroom

What does this mean for you at home?

- * Your student could be assigned 1 or more videos/ presentations per week.
- * These videos will be 5-10 minute instructional videos that were created by us. Your student will be taking notes during the video and answering 2-4 follow up questions after the video.
- *Remember, even if IXL is not assigned, it can ALWAYS be used for review and/or extra practice! :)

Homework and Coaching

- * Homework policy homework IS checked, but it is NOT part of a student's grade
- * Coaching Time is every morning from 7:30 8:30. Students can visit any of their teachers during this time for extra help, to make up work, and to ask questions.
