Kindergarten

Personal Items for Individual Student Use:

- 2 1" White 3-ring presentation binder with pockets inside
- 1 pack of 5 tab binder dividers
- 1 plain yellow plastic folder with 2 pockets and brads
- 1 container of Play-Doh
- 1 hard plastic school pencil box
- 1 pair blunt tip scissors (Fiskars preferred)
- 1 large pink eraser
- 2 black dry erase markers
- 1 pair of quality headphones for technology labeled with your child's name. No ear buds or wireless headphones. No volume button on cord
- 1 reusable spill-proof water bottle with your child's name
- 1 change of clothes (underwear, socks, jean shorts, and a red or navy plain t-shirt (not a uniform shirt) placed in a gallon size bag with your child's name on each article of clothing and on the outside of the bag

Classroom Supplies:

- 1 pack of pre sharpened yellow pencils (Ticonderoga preferred)
- 2 fat glue sticks (.77 oz-Elmer's preferred)
- 2 boxes of classic color crayons- 24 count (Crayola preferred)

Boys: 1 box of tissues, 1 box of sandwich sized Ziploc bags

Girls: 1 container of disinfecting wipes, 1 box of gallon size Ziploc bags

A note from the teachers:

- Backpacks must be large enough for a binder
- Please unbox headphones and place them in a gallon bag with your child's name

- hard plastic school pencil box (no cloth pouches, please)
- 1 large pink eraser
- 1 pair of blunt tip scissors
- 2 boxes of crayons- 24 count (Crayola preferred)
- 1 pack of washable markers (Crayola preferred)
- 1 pair of headphones (no earbuds)

Classroom Supplies

- 2 packs of glue sticks (Elmer's preferred)

Second Grade

Personal Items for Individual Student Use:

- 2 spiral notebooks-WIDE RULED
- 1 pair of headphones (over the ear, not buds-please unbox headphones and place them in a gallon bag with your child's name)
- 1 hard plastic school pencil box
- 2 big pink erasers (Pink Pearl preferred)
- 1 pair of scissors
- 2 boxes of 24 count crayons (Crayola preferred)

- 1 wide ruled spiral notebook
- 1 black and white composition notebook-wide ruled
- 1 pair of earbuds/headphones (not wireless)
- 1 pencil pouch
- 1 pair of scissors (Fiskar is preferred)
- 2 boxes of crayons- 24 count (Crayola preferred)
- 1 pack of 8 count thick washable markers (Crayola preferred)

Classroom Supplies:

- 2 fat glue sticks (.77 oz-Elmer's preferred)
- 1 pack of pre sharpened pencils (Ticonderoga preferred)
- 1 container of disinfecting wipes

- 1 spiral notebook
- 1-2 pairs of earbuds
- 1 pack of markers (Crayola preferred)
- 1 pencil pouch

Items to be kept in pencil pouch daily:

- sharpened pencils
- glue sticks
- 1 pack of colored pencils
- 1 pair of small scissors
- 1 highlighter-any color

Classroom Supplies:

- 1 pack of Expo markers
- 2 packs of pre sharpened pencils

Sixth Grade
